## PATIENT INFORMATION: REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

Did you know that you can now order your repeat medication on line? Simply go to our website [www.stthomasmedicalgroup.co.uk](http://www.stthomasmedicalgroup.co.uk) and register with us.

You will then be sent a Password. Once you have this you are able to access the website and order your repeat medication. A confirmation email will be sent telling you that your medication is ready for collection. Any problems please do not hesitate to contact Marie, Dr Kernick's Secretary on Exeter 676667.



Would you prefer to order your repeat prescription by fax? We are happy to accept requests for repeat prescriptions this way. Our fax number is **01392 676677**. Again please make sure you state clearly your name, address, telephone number and precise details of your medication. Again 48 hours notice is required

### PLEASE NOTE:

**Unfortunately we are not able to take Repeat Prescription requests over the telephone. They have to be in writing - sorry!**

**48 hours notice** needs to be given for prescription requests. Prescriptions received:

8.30am Monday will be ready after 2pm Wednesday

8.30am Tuesday.....Thursday

8.30am Wednesday.....Friday

8.30am Thursday.....Monday

8.30am Friday.....Tuesday

Posted through letter box on Sat/Sun..... Wednesday

### Does your repeat medication rarely change?

If your repeat medication rarely changes then you may consider joining the Repeat Dispensing Scheme. This Scheme enables your GP to issue enough prescriptions to cover you until your next birthday then your medication will be reviewed and, if still stable, your GP will issue enough medication to cover you for the next twelve months.

This will save you numerous trips to the Surgery to request your medication as it will be waiting for you to collect at the Pharmacy of your choice. Should you like to know more about this Scheme please contact your GP, his Secretary or your local Pharmacist.

You can request that your prescription gets forwarded to one of the following Pharmacies for collection by yourself, at a time to suit: **LUXTONS, ALLIANCE, BOOTS, SAINSBURY'S, SUPERDRUG** and **ST. LEONARD'S** please indicate your preference on your request. Thank you.

**Over 60?** The Primary Care Trust's Policy is that patients over the age of 60 have prescriptions for 28 days only.

### Surgery closed?

Simply pop your prescription request through the Pharmacy letterbox, preferably in an envelope.
