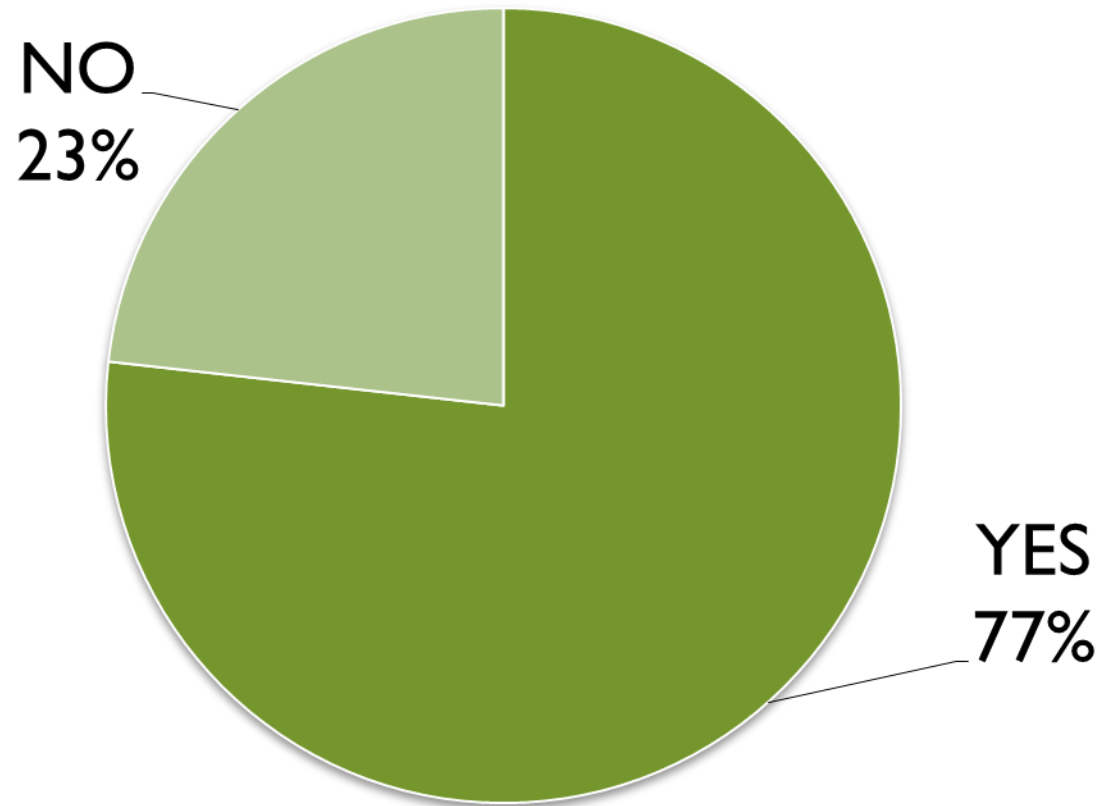

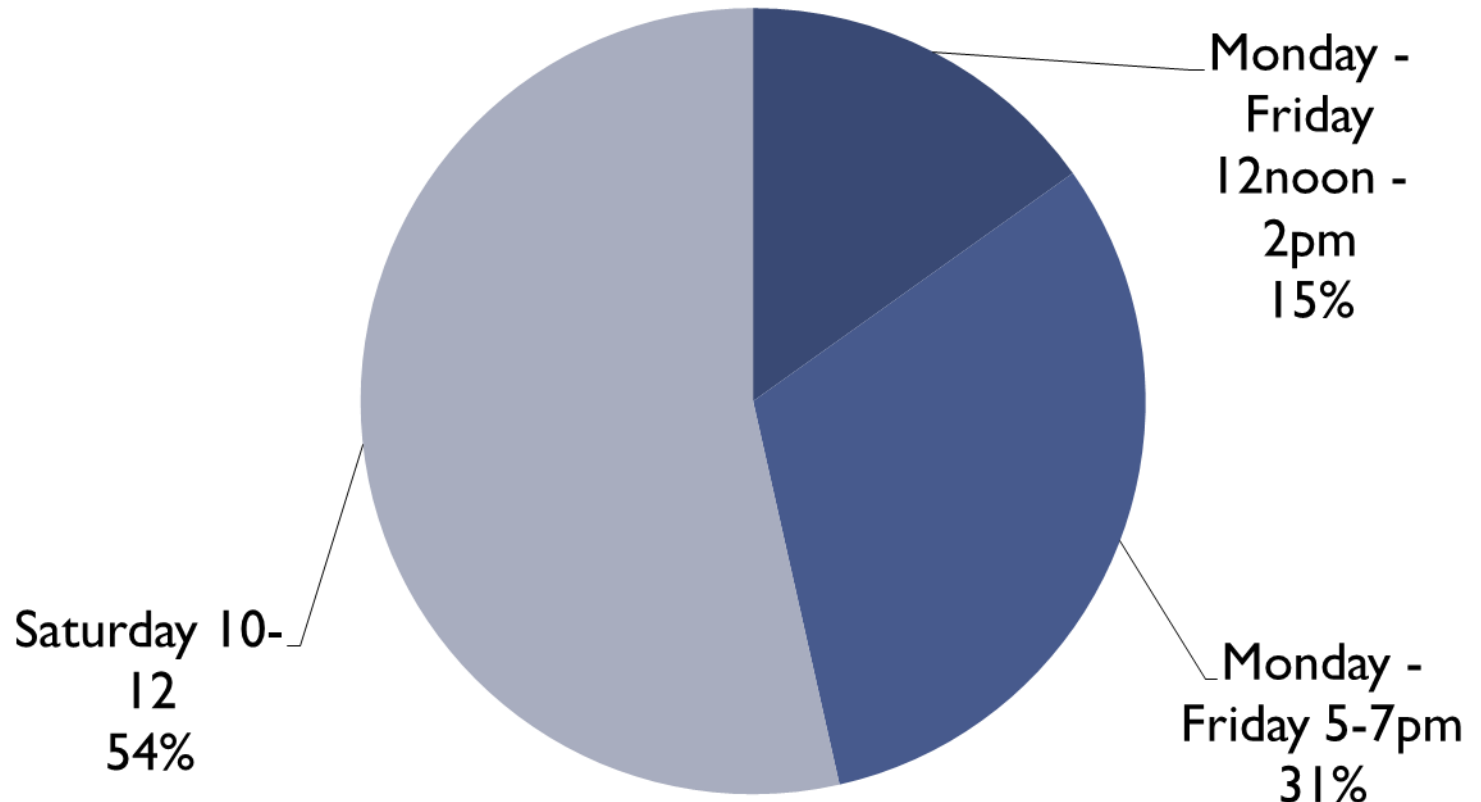
SURGERY TIMES

Do you find the times we offer suitable?



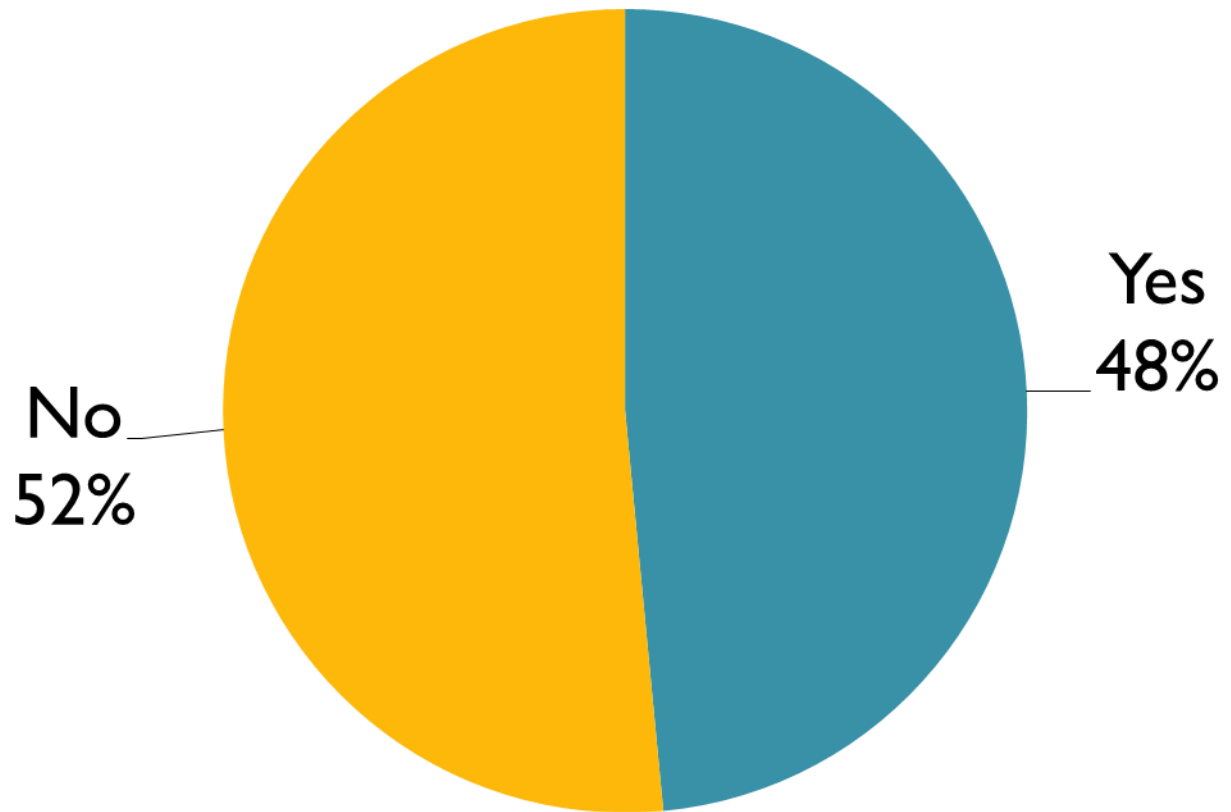

SURGERY TIMES If "NO" which times would you prefer?



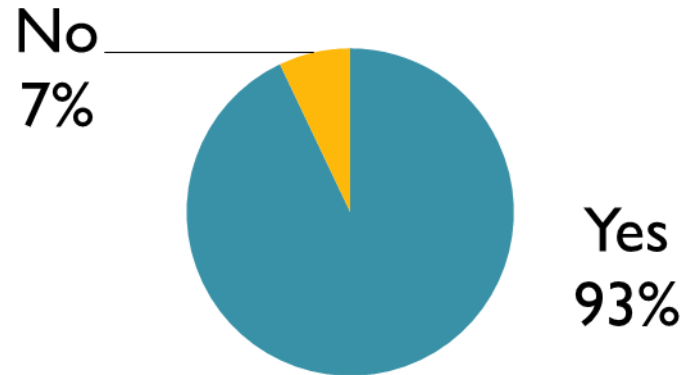

SAME DAY ILLNESS CLINIC Have you used this Clinic before?

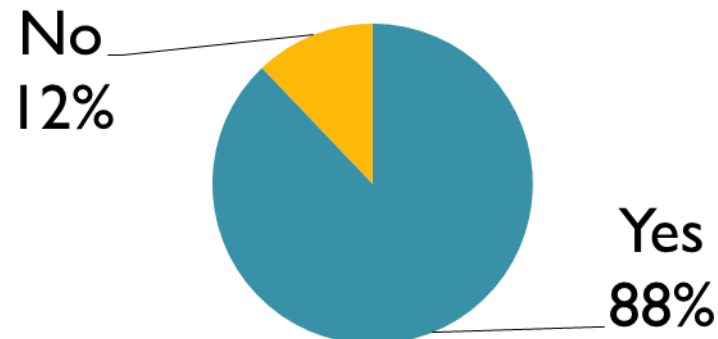

If "YES" was the time convenient?

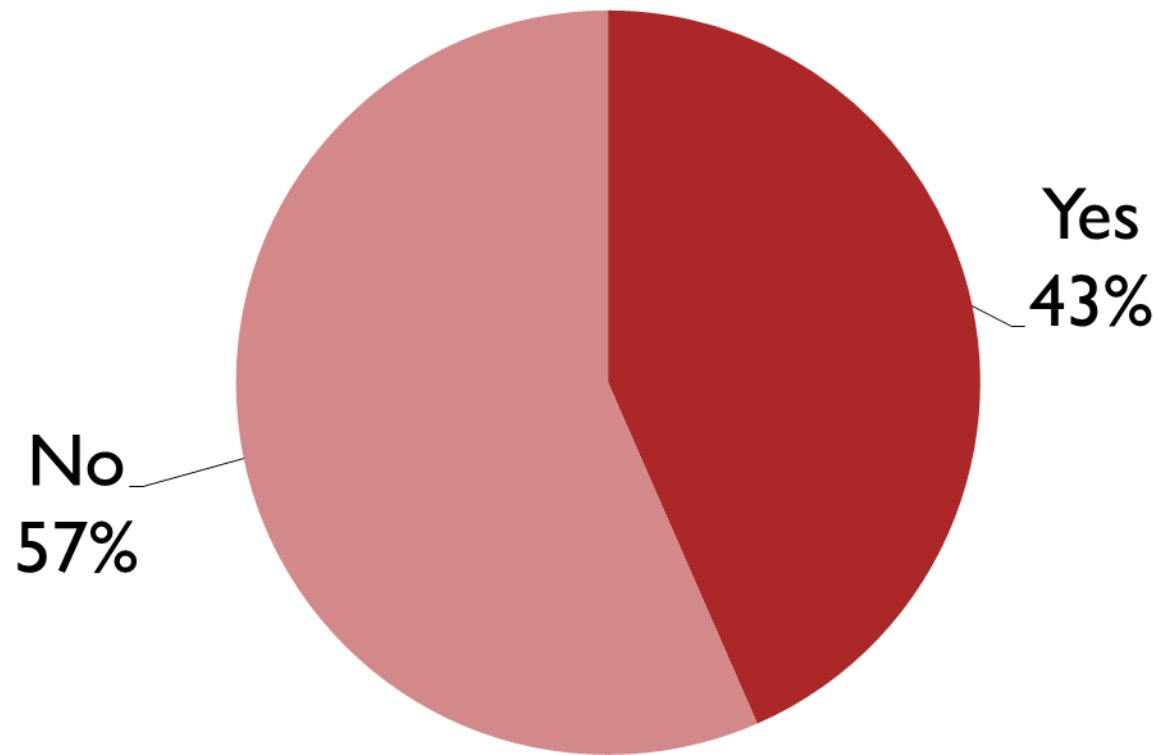


Was the wait to be seen acceptable?



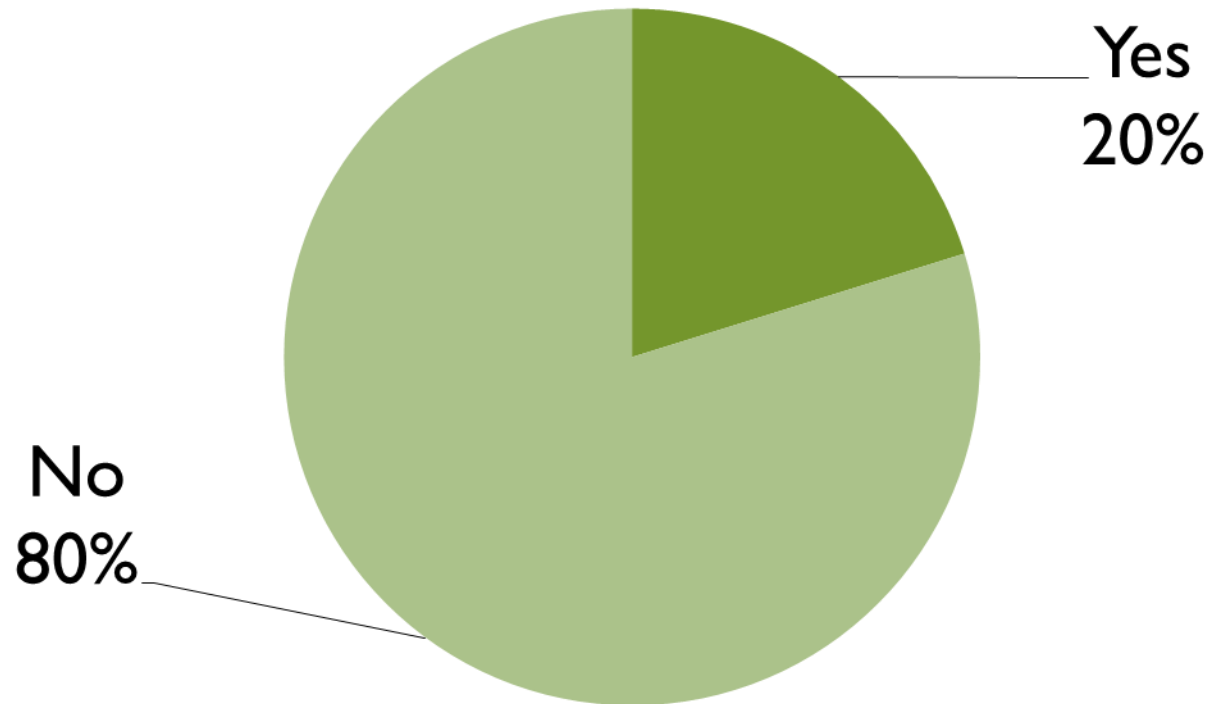

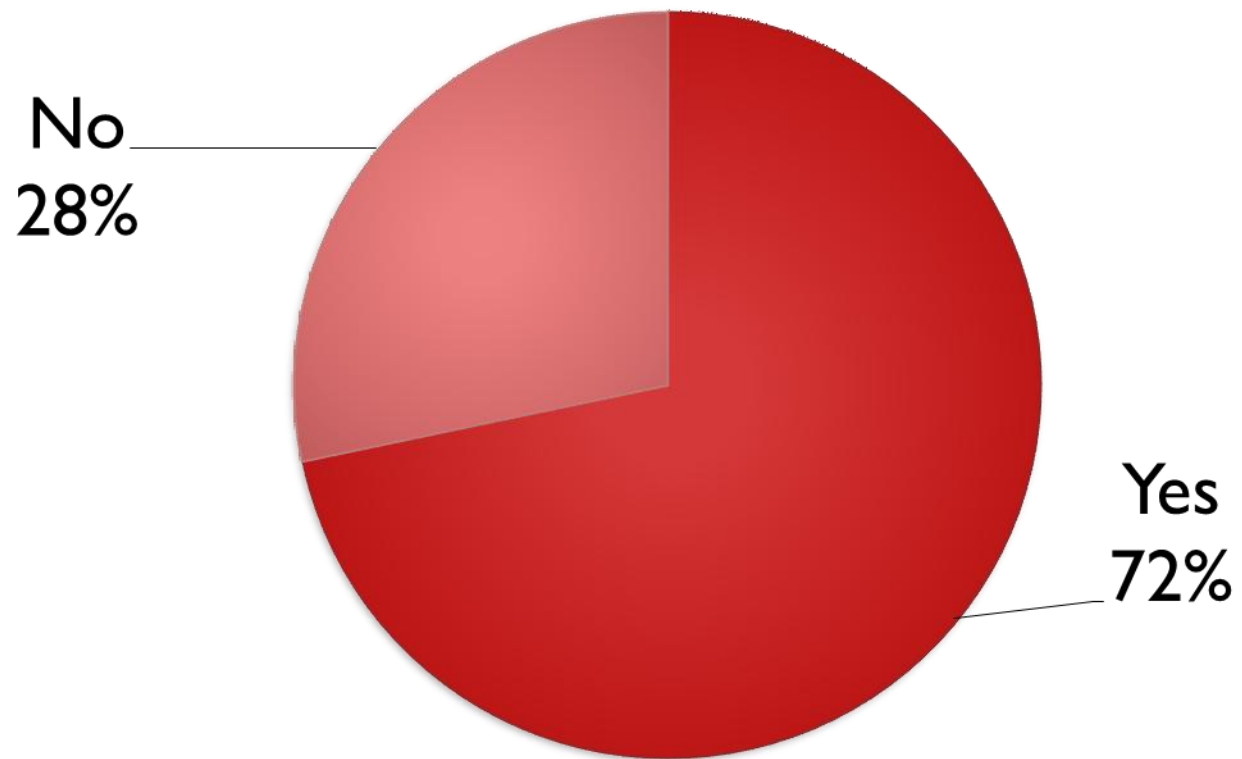

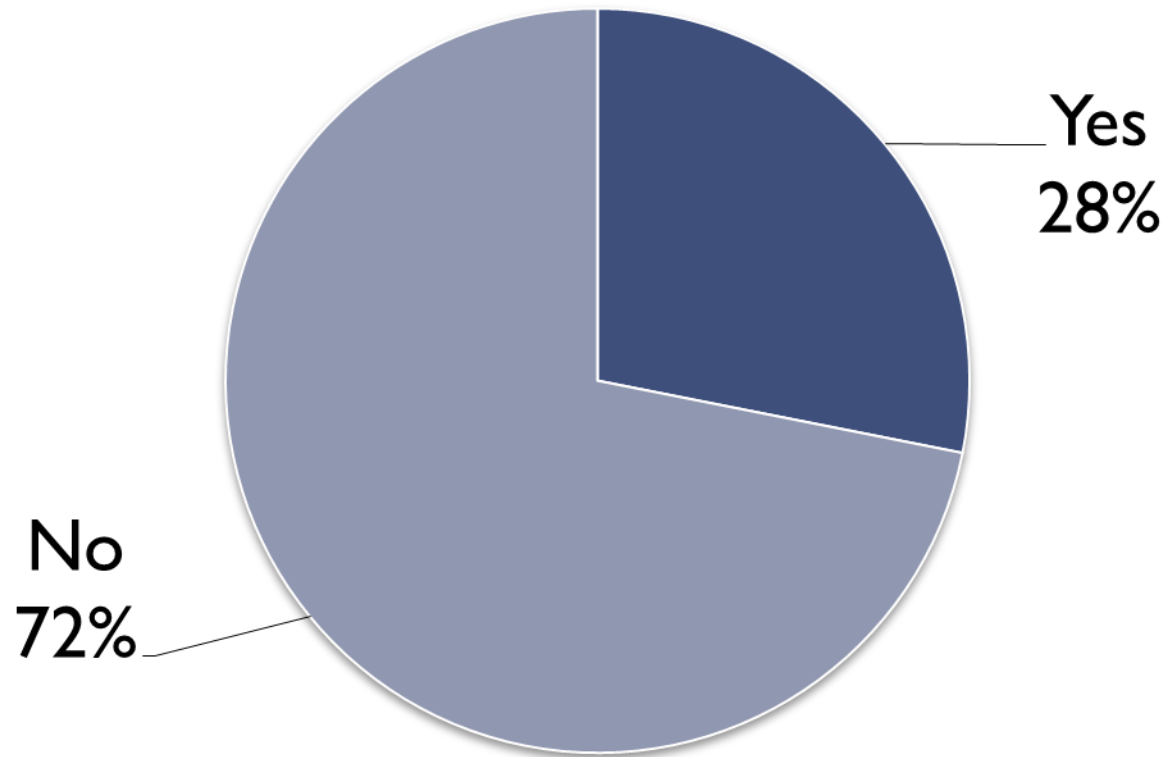

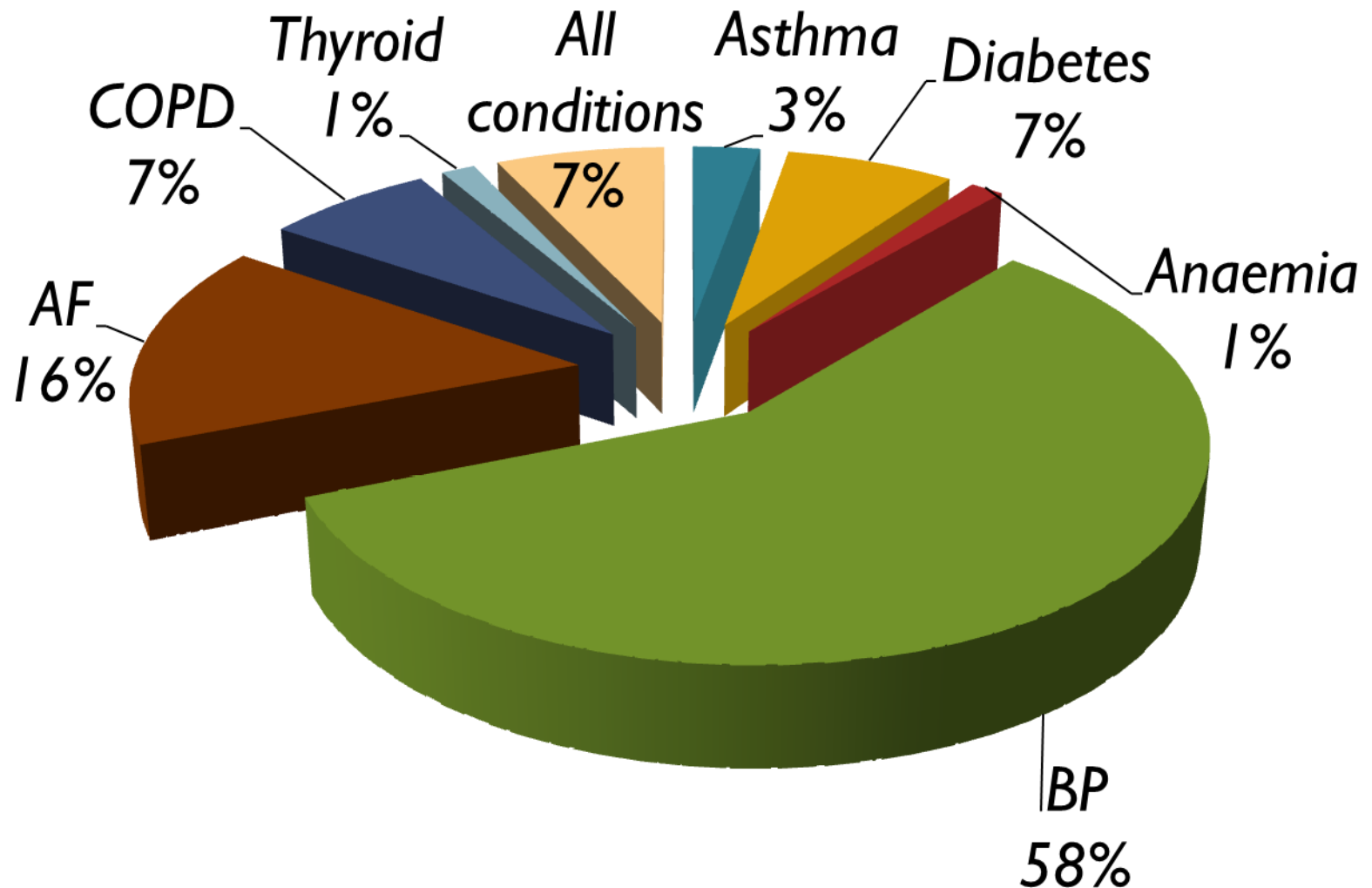
